The time commitment and financial component was discussed. Mayor Friedman and Councilmember Gold discussed Mayoral goals within a Mayor's term. Councilmember Gold praised Mayor Friedman for his leadership response to COVID-19. Councilmember Gold discussed age group demographic statistics in the City.
