Earthquake



MyShake - MyShake provides earthquake early warnings in California for estimated magnitude 4.5 earthquakes and higher to phones in the light shaking (MMI 3) or higher areas. Earthquake early warning provides the opportunity for users to take life safety protective actions in advance of shaking.



QuakeFeed - Check on earthquakes affecting you or your loved ones and gain a unique perspective on earthquakes around the world. Set up zones to watch for earthquakes in a number of easily configurable ways.



Earthquake: American Red Cross - Empower your family to stay safe and remain calm in an emergency by learning how to make and practice an emergency plan. Step-by-step instructions provide you with information regarding what to do before/during/after earthquakes.

First Aid



First Aid: American Red Cross - Learn how to prepare for everyday emergencies via expert advice from the American Red Cross First Aid app by viewing videos, interactive quizzes and simple step-by-step instruction guides.



Pet First Aid - Take care of your furry family member, learn first aid steps for over 25 common pet situations through a combination of text, video and images, and also learn how to identify common toxic substances.

Set up your **Medical ID** in the Health app on your iPhone or download with Google Play for Androids. Medical ID helps first responders access your critical medical information from the lock screen, without needing your passcode. First responders can see information like allergies and medical conditions as well as who to contact in case of an emergency.
